



Rooftop Tent User Manual

All Models: CFRTT, LWRTT-S & LWRTT-XL

INSTALLATION

1. You will need to confirm the suitability of your vehicle and roof rack prior to fitment. This information is available from your specific vehicle and roof rack manufacturers.
2. Follow the installation video for correct use of the supplied fitment hardware.



3. Once installed, regularly check the nuts and bolts are tight and in good condition. It is your responsibility to ensure the tent is safely attached to your vehicle at all times.

USER TIPS

4. The Carbon Fibre Model (code: CFRTT) features a hybrid foam mattress. The mattress is self inflating, the valve is marked with an inflate and deflate mode. You can use a power assisted pump (sold separately) to assist the inflation of the mat and reach your desired level of firmness and comfort.

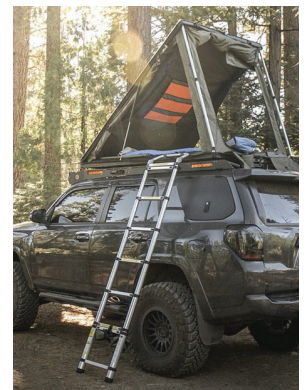
Like all hybrid and self inflating mattresses this has an air tight outer fabric. Keep away from sharp objects at all times to avoid puncture and loss of air.

5. Avoid storing your rooftop tent wet. If conditions make it unavoidable, make sure you open the tent and dry it out as soon as possible to avoid any mould or damage.

SAFETY WARNINGS

6. For your safety ensure you use the ladder supplied. Do not climb the ladder unless it is attached correctly and is at a safe angle.

Always maintain 3 points of contact while using the ladder.



7. Do not operate any heater or other appliance that burns fuel inside of the tent. Keep all flame and heat sources away from the tent materials. Keep camp fires well away from the tent and be aware of possible airborne burning embers.

WARRANTY

8. Inspired Overland Rooftop Tents come with a one year warranty which covers faulty manufacturing, materials and workmanship. Australian warranty claims are made directly to Snowys.
